ORAL PRESENTATION GUIDELINE

- Your presentation should be prepared under powerpoint, with a slide format for 16:9 screen
- Please name your power point file according the following format: oral-session-number.IGSC5.presenter name.ppt/pptx
- Your oral presentation time in total 10 minutes including Q&A
- Avoid small font size! Font size 24 is usually a minimum size for the text. Use fonts that have been used widely for formal/ academic presentation, for example: Arial, TNR, Verdana, Helvetica, Futura.
- Make a good contrast between text and background (E.g: dark text on light back ground)
- If color is used to emphasize the importance of selected text or convey other meaning, an alternate method (such as bold text) should also be used.

Background (1-2 slides, 1 – 2 mins presentation)

- **Background of study**
- **Provide rationale for study**
- **Essential information (only) about project – ensure relevance**
- **Include a slide describing study objectives**

Method (1-2 slides, 1 – 2 mins presentation)

- **Describe Study Designs**
- **Describe Study Groups and reasons for selection**
- **Describe what methods/tests were used**

Results and Discussion (3 – 5 slides, 4-5 mins presentation)

- **Highlight most important findings**
- **Describe characteristics of study participants, cohort, etc.**
- **Include descriptive results and analytic results**
- **Use mixture of text, tables, figures, photos as appropriate to your data**
- **Interpretation of findings**
 - Don't repeat results
 - Prioritize findings from most to least important
 - – Link findings to study objectives
 - Put findings into context with previous studies

Conclusion (1 – 2 slides, 1 – 2 mins presentation)

- **Conclusions slide(s) based on your findings**
- **Recommendations slide(s) – Directions for future studies**
- **Limitations slide (only the important ones)**

Acknowledgements (1 slide, 10 – 15 seconds)

- **Recognize co-authors and contributors**
- **Same logos as on title slide**
- **Your last words = “Thank You”**
